OUR EDUCATIONAL OFFERINGS

What your partnership makes possible

We continually strive to provide meaningful education, information, and resources to those seeking to reimagine agriculture. Our offerings continue to evolve as we listen to and collaborate with both the current and potential biodynamic community to understand what best meets the various needs across our large and diverse country — and, indeed, beyond. To meet these needs, we offer education and information in a variety of formats: introductory and advanced, online and in-person, shorter and longer, live and recorded, and verbal and written. As a Partner, we will appreciate hearing from you about potential news paths for meeting the tremendous demand for a healing agriculture and new approach to the many issues facing our world today.

Conferences & Gatherings

The [Online Biodynamic Conference](#), held in 2024 from November 22-24, invited participants from across the US and around the world to reimagine the future of agriculture by exploring how biodynamics can weave together the social, spiritual, and scientific to nurture new possibilities. Participants benefit from three inspiring keynote presentations complemented by two tracks of three-day themed workshops. Recordings of all sessions are available to participants after the event.

We look forward to collaborating with regional organizations, farms, and groups on in-person gatherings in 2025.

Biodynamic Foundations Training

For those seeking more in-depth and longer-term training, the [Biodynamic Foundations Training](#) program offers the opportunity for a full immersion into the many facets of biodynamic agriculture. The program's main elements include an integrated, participatory curriculum, a cohort-based video conference classroom component, an on-farm skills development guide, an independent project, and monthly individual check-ins. A variety of readings, exercises, and structured, self-directed elements bring greater understanding and build capacities to participate more deeply and fully in caring for their farm or land.

Online Courses & Webinars

We offer a variety of [online opportunities](#) to help people learn about biodynamics wherever they live, including individual webinars, webinar series, and longer online courses. Recordings are available after the event.

In the winter and spring of 2025, we are introducing a new series of [Core Biodynamics](#) courses that will allow individuals either to choose the modules that meet their interests or to attend them all for a full picture of biodynamics as a path for a healing agriculture. Topics will include Goethean science and plant development, soil health and composting, caring for animals, inner development and spiritual science, healthy social life, and understanding cosmic influences.

In-Person Training

We collaborate with local and regional organizations, farms, and groups to organize in-person trainings. In the summer of 2024, we trialed a successful three-day [Biodynamic Intensive](#) in the Hudson Valley of New York in collaboration with local partners. In the winter of 2025, we will follow up with a three-day workshop in New York focused on a “New Path for Agriculture.”

Scholarships

The [Biodynamic Scholarship Fund](#) helps make biodynamic education accessible to all who are interested, enabling them to take what they've learned onto their land and into their communities, sharing with others and broadening the impact of biodynamics. We offer scholarships for educational opportunities we organize and host, as well as for those offered by other organizations around the country.
